*The pitot tube is the long metal tube at the front of an aircraft. It can be on the nose, next to the fuselage, under the wing, or anywhere towards the front of the aircraft following the axis of the body of the aircraft. This would allow the air to flow smoothly over the tube in whichever direction the aircraft is heading to provide an accurate reading.*
